Baptismal Preparation Requirements

(Our Living Covenant: Policies and Procedures for the Diocese of Prince Albert, 4.2.1)

1. Normal preparation for the celebration of infant baptism should involve three sessions.
2. Baptism should be celebrated communally and preferably during the Sunday celebration, unless a valid pastoral reason dictates otherwise.
3. Parents who have already participated in Baptismal Preparation are encouraged to participate in the Baptismal Preparation Program, to share and deepen their understanding of baptism and their faith.
4. Parishes are encouraged to have a follow-up process.

ORDINARY TIME. In his Apostolic Letter approving the Roman Calendar (14 Feb 1969), Pope Paul VI noted some important facts about the Liturgical Year:

Over many centuries, Catholics had become accustomed to so many special religious devotions that the mysteries of redemption lost their proper place. This was due to the large number of vigils, holydays and octaves, and to the growing dominance of various seasons over the Church year;

St. Pius X and St. John XXIII restored Sunday to its former dignity, so that everyone should once more consider it as the Church's original Feast Day;

The Popes restated the traditional teaching of the Church: The celebration of the Liturgical Year has a special sacramental power and force which nourishes and strengthens the life of Christians, the Church year is not merely a recalling of the historical events by which Christ won our salvation;

Prerequisites for Sponsors

[Canon 873, 874. §1 & §2]

1. There is to be only one male sponsor or one female sponsor or one of each;
2. Designated by the one to be baptized, by the parents or the person who takes their place, or in their absence by the pastor or minister and have the aptitude and intention of fulfilling this function;
3. Have completed the sixteenth year of age, unless the diocesan bishop has established another age, or the pastor or minister has granted an exception for a just cause;
4. A Catholic who has been confirmed and has already received the most holy sacrament of the Eucharist and who leads a life of faith in keeping with the function to be taken on;
5. Not bound by any canonical penalty legitimately imposed or declared;
6. Not the father or mother of the one to be baptized.
7. A baptized person who belongs to a non-Catholic ecclesial community is not to participate except together with a Catholic sponsor and then only as a witness of the baptism.

The reason for the restoration of the Liturgical Year is to help believers through their faith, hope and love to share more fully in the entire mystery of Christ as it is unfolding throughout the year. Cf. ORDO 2018-2019, p. 252.
